STEWARDSHIP REFLECTION

We celebrate today what is popularly called the Feast of Christ the King (the official Church name is The Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe). In this particular year 2016, however, it is a greater celebration than usual. As always we commemorate the fact that our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ is indeed the King of the Universe.



In his encyclical establishing this observation in the Church (this only occurred in 1925, some 91 years ago) Pope Pius XI declared, "He (Jesus) must reign in our minds, which should assent with perfect submission and firm belief to revealed truths and to the doctrines of Christ. He must reign in our wills, which should obey the laws and precepts of God. He must reign in our hearts, which should spurn natural desires and love God above all things." His point was that Christ needs to be at the center of our lives, which is exactly what stewardship calls for — living Christ-centered lives.

It was Pope Paul VI who moved this time to rejoice to this date, which is also the final Sunday of our liturgical year, as Advent and the new Church year begin next week. Finally, today also marks the culmination of our Holy Year of Mercy. The word "mercy" appears some 276 times in the Bible (almost the same as the word "truth"). Jesus told us it is never too late for mercy, for conversion, for making Him the center of our lives.

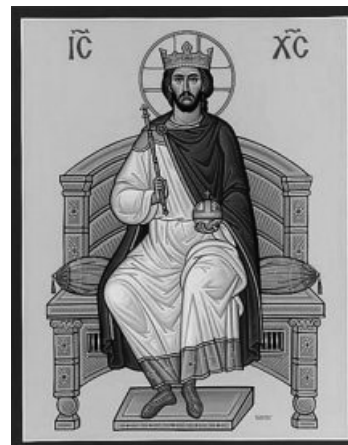

REFLECIÓN DOMINICAL

Hoy celebramos lo que se conoce popularmente como la Fiesta de Cristo Rey (el nombre oficial de la Iglesia es la Solemnidad de Nuestro Señor Jesucristo, Rey del Universo). En particular, este año 2016, sin embargo, es una celebración mayor de lo habitual. Como siempre conmemoramos el hecho de que nuestro Señor y Salvador Jesucristo, es de hecho el Rey del Universo.



En su encíclica el establecimiento de esta observación en la Iglesia (esto sólo ocurrió en 1925, hace unos 91 años), el Papa Pío XI declaró: "Él (Jesús) debe reinar en nuestra mente, que debe asentir con perfecta sumisión y la firme creencia de verdades reveladas y a las doctrinas de Cristo. Él debe reinar en nuestra voluntad, que debe obedecer las leyes y preceptos de Dios. Él debe reinar en nuestros corazones, que deben despreciar los deseos naturales y amar a Dios sobre todas las cosas "Su punto era que Cristo tiene que estar en el centro de nuestras vidas, que es exactamente lo que la administración exige -. Vivir una vida centrada en Cristo.

Fue el Papa Pablo VI, que se trasladó este momento para alegrarse de esta fecha, que es también el último domingo del año litúrgico, como Adviento y el nuevo año de la Iglesia comienzan la próxima semana. Por último, hoy en día también marca la culminación de nuestra Año Santo de la Merced. La palabra "misericordia" aparece unas 276 veces en la Biblia (casi lo mismo que la palabra "verdad"). Jesús nos dijo que nunca es demasiado tarde para que la misericordia, de conversión, de hacer de Él el centro de nuestras vidas.

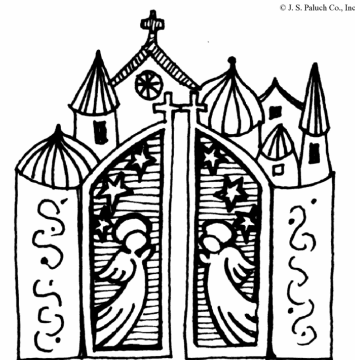
If you did not have your portrait taken at our church by Lifetouch, we still want you in our book. You can submit your own picture, the cost is \$15 and that will include our new book.
