

## REFLECIÓN DOMINICAL

Nuestro Evangelio de Juan 14 narra lo que Jesús dice a sus discípulos mientras se prepara para salir de ellas. En concreto, el Señor dice: "La paz os dejo, mi paz os doy. No como el mundo la da, yo la daré." Usted puede ser consciente de que en tiempos de Jesús (así como en muchas partes del mundo hoy) el saludo común fue Shalom . Eso significa, por supuesto, la "paz". Sin embargo, es no sólo un saludo, pero también es lo que decía la gente cuando se separaron.



Jesús hace un punto de dejar claro a sus seguidores y para nosotros que Él no es sólo decir "Paz" la forma en la gente suele hacer, sino de lo que se llena con más fuerza y sentido. Es "No como la da el mundo" que Jesús está diciendo: "Paz a vosotros." Jesús nos dice que Él por medio del Espíritu Santo siempre estará con nosotros, de pie junto a nosotros, y nos fortalezca. Eso es algo que debemos creer. Confiado en el Señor es un aspecto clave de la administración.

En nuestro mundo que son más propensos a decir "Adiós" que "Shalom". Sin embargo, a pesar de que tiene un significado con un mensaje mucho más profundo. "Adiós" se deriva de la despedida "Dios sea con usted" o "Dios sea con vosotros." Por lo tanto, cuando decimos "adiós" también estamos dando a alguien el mismo mensaje que Jesús nos da. Dios está con nosotros - siempre. Él te ama.
