## Fr. Gerard's Corner

Wisdom is personified in quite an intimate and innocent way by the author of Proverbs in the first reading: "I was (God's) delight day by day, playing before (God) all the while, playing on the surface of (God's) earth; and I found delight in the human race" (Proverbs 8:30-31). This is not the picture normally painted of God in the Old Testament. What a wonderful way to imagine God, having created the heavens and earth and everything in them, delighting in all this handiwork. May we do the same.

God is love. It is one of the first lessons we learn about God, and one of the simplest to understand. (Certainly much easier than three persons in one God.) But love only makes sense in relationship with someone else. A mother loves her child, a husband loves his wife, two good friends love each other. Father, Son, and Holy Spirit love each other with an unparalleled love, a perfect love. It is love that is ever-generous, ever-selfless. It is the love that brought God to create the human race, that brought Jesus to redeem the human race, that brought the Holy Spirit to sanctify the human race, through God's very presence in us. They are the very model of love for us: a lasting commitment to someone else.

Saint Paul admits that not everything is rosy in our world. We are beset with afflictions. But our sufferings are not the end. Our sufferings build endurance, our endurance builds character, and our character leads to hope, and hope will always last. In his first letter to the Corinthians, Paul asserts that faith, hope, and love remain. In this reading, he mentions all three virtues as well, and each traces its origin to the Trinity.

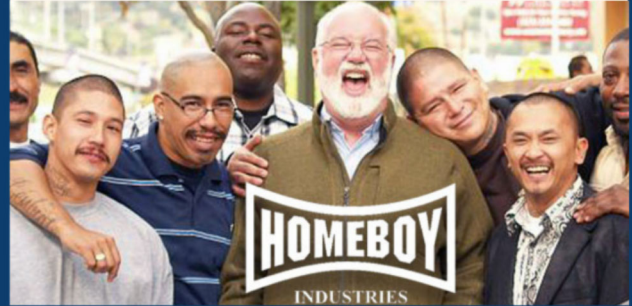

## El rincón del P. Gerardo

La sabiduría es personificada de una manera bien íntima e inocente por el autor de los Proverbios en la primera lectura: “Todo el tiempo me recreaba en su presencia (de Dios), jugando con el orbe de la tierra y mis delicias eran estar con los hijos de los hombres” (Proverbios 8, 30–31). Ésta nos es la manera en que normalmente se describe a Dios en el Antiguo Testamento. Qué manera tan hermosa de imaginarnos a Dios, que habiendo creado los cielos y la tierra, y todo lo que en ellos existe, se deleita en toda su obra. También nosotros hemos de hacer lo mismo.

Dios es amor. Ésta es una de las primeras lecciones que aprendemos acerca de Dios y una de las más sencillas de entender. (Ciertamente mucho más fácil que en Dios hay tres personas). Pero el amor sólo tiene sentido en una relación con otra persona. Una madre ama a su hijo o hija, un esposo ama a su esposa, dos buenos amigos se aman mutuamente. El Padre, el Hijo, y el Espíritu Santo se aman entre sí con un amor sinigual y perfecto, pues su amor es siempre generoso y siempre desprendido. Es ése el amor que hizo que Dios creara el género humano, que hizo que Jesús redimiera al género humano, que hizo que el Espíritu Santo santificara al género humano, por la misma presencia de Dios en nosotros. Ése es el modelo verdadero de amor para nosotros: un compromiso perdurable con otra persona.

San Pablo admite que no todo es de color de rosa en este mundo nuestro. Estamos rodeados de aflicciones, pero nuestros sufrimientos no son el fin. Nuestros sufrimientos forjan la resiliencia, nuestra resiliencia forja nuestro carácter y nuestro carácter nos conduce hacia la esperanza, a una esperanza que perdura. En la primera carta a los corintios Pablo afirma que la fe, la esperanza y el amor permanecen. En esta lectura él menciona esas tres virtudes y cada una de ellas tiene su origen en la Santísima Trinidad.
