## Fr. Gerard's Corner

With mass shootings and acts of domestic terrorism on the increase while the “war on terror” continues, we can identify all too easily with Jeremiah’s words: “Terror on every side!” (Jeremiah 20:10). Jeremiah himself continually felt threatened because he repeatedly condemned the unfaithful kings of Judah. Jeremiah constantly struggled with his calling. When even his friends turn against him, he succumbs to doubt and anger. Yet he perseveres in his mission. He convinces himself that with the LORD at his side his enemies will not win in the end. Just as God has rescued the poor and the persecuted, God will rescue him.

Both Jeremiah and the psalmist are subjected to abuse, even from those close to them. Jeremiah’s former friends “are on the watch for any misstep of mine” (Jeremiah 20:10). The psalmist has “become an outcast to my kin, a stranger to my mother’s children” (Psalm 69:9). In the end, both place their trust in the LORD. “Sing to the LORD . . . for he has rescued the life of the poor,” says Jeremiah (20:13). “I pray to you, O LORD, . . . for the LORD hears the poor,” says the psalmist (69:14, 34). God’s mercy to the neediest gives them confidence.

Jeremiah pleads to God not just for deliverance, but retribution. “Let me witness the vengeance you take on them,” he prays (20:12). He wants to see his enemies hurt as badly as they’ve hurt him. Jesus wants his disciples to stay strong despite rejection and persecution. He assures them repeatedly, “Do not be afraid” (10:26, 28, 31). How can he say this? Because he knows his Father’s care exceeds any harm the world can inflict. This enables him to take up his cross when facing the ultimate persecution. May we be assured of God’s care through all our trials.

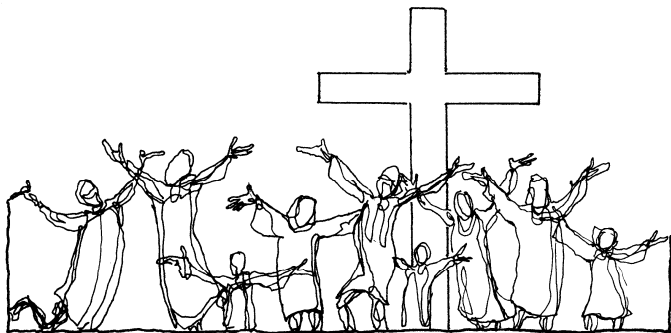

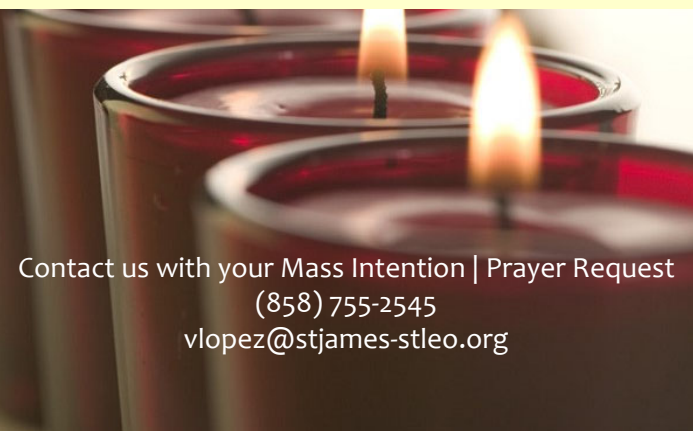

## **Temporary Accommodations to Mass at St. James-St. Leo**

We are committed to providing a safe environment as we return to Mass.

These accommodations are until further notice, and subject to change.

Please note: The first several weeks at 5pm in the church will fill quickly due to sacraments.

### **The following accommodations will be observed:**

- High-risk persons should not attend, and anyone with symptoms is not to attend.
- Facemasks are required at all Masses, whether indoors or out (over age four).
- No-touch temperatures will be taken upon entering.
- Hand sanitizer is available at the entrance.
- Available seating is clearly designated with appropriate spacing.
- Collection boxes are available at the entrance for Sunday envelopes.
- All fonts will be empty of water.
- Missalettes are removed, but will be given away for personal use while supplies last. You are encouraged to bring your own.
- Bulletins will be available for pickup, but not handed out by ushers.
- Restrooms are limited to one person/family at a time.
- Drinking fountains and social room are not available.
- Vestry is for authorized persons only (clergy, staff, sacristans).
- Prayer chapel is for pass-through only before and after Mass.
- One person at a time in the sacristy.
- One entrance is observed, with all doors open during Mass for airflow. There will be multiple exits.
- All locations will be sanitized between Masses.
- No physical contact occurs during Sign of Peace or Lord's Prayer.
- Communion is distributed at the end of Mass, after the final blessing, as people are dismissed by row. After receiving, the person then exits.
- There is to be no gathering after Mass.
- Communion is host only, in the hand. (Step aside, pull down mask to consume.)
- Eucharistic ministers will be scheduled, with fewer needed for each Mass due to fewer people and no Cup. Priests over 65 are asked to not distribute communion.
- EM's will use a mask with sanitized hands. Any contact requires re-sanitation.
- Hospitality ushers will be scheduled, with more needed.
- Altar servers will not be scheduled during this time.

### **Each Mass location is limited to 100 persons total, so the following is observed:**

- Entrance into St. James church or hall for a particular Mass will require a reservation through Signup Genius. Those unable to get online can call the office.
- Those assisting at Mass (presiders, lectors, ushers, sacristans, EM's) should not sign up, as they are already counted.
- We must limit indoor attendance, but people without reservations or who are high risk may attend outdoors with social distancing, and may then receive communion outdoors after Mass. Weekend Masses at St. James church will be live streamed and may be watched through personal devices, or with audio from patio.
- Mass will be held at both the church and the parish hall to accommodate more people. However, the first several weeks at 5pm in the church will fill quickly due to sacraments (RCIA and 1st Communion). Confirmation Mass is still to be scheduled.



## El Ricón del Padre Gerardo

Con el aumento de las matanzas a balas y otros actos domésticos de terrorismo a pesar de la “guerra al terror”, nos podemos identificar muy bien con las palabras de Jeremías: “Terror por todas partes” (Jeremías 20, 10). El mismo Jeremías se sentía continuamente amenazado por denunciar una y otra vez a los reyes infieles de Judá. Jeremías luchaba constantemente con su llamado, y cede a la duda y al enojo cuando hasta sus amigos se vuelven en contra de él. Pero sin embargo persevera en su misión. Se convence a sí mismo de que con el Señor a su lado sus enemigos no saldrán victoriosos. Así como Dios ha rescatado al pobre y al perseguido, también lo rescatará a él.

Tanto Jeremías como el salmista están sometidos al abuso, aun por parte de sus más cercanos. Los que habían sido amigos de Jeremías “espiaban mis pasos” (Jeremías 20, 10). El salmista “extraño soy y advenedizo, aun para aquellos de mi propia sangre” (Salmo 69, 9). Al final ambos ponen su confianza en el Señor. “Canten y alaben al Señor . . . porque él ha salvado la vida de su pobre”, dice Jeremías (20, 13). “Señor, elevo mi plegaria, . . . porque el Señor jamás desoye al pobre”, dice el salmista (69, 14. 34). La misericordia de Dios hacia los necesitados les da confianza.

Jeremías clama a Dios no sólo para que lo libere, sino para que tenga venganza. Su oración clama: “Haz que yo vea tu venganza contra ellos” (20, 12). Quiere verlos sufrir, así como ellos lo han hecho sufrir a él. Jesús quiere que sus discípulos permanezcan fuertes a pesar del rechazo y la persecución; por eso les dice repetidamente: “No tengan miedo” (Mateo 10, 26. 28. 31). ¿Por qué puede decirnos eso? Porque sabe que el cuidado de su Padre excede cualquier daño que el mundo pueda infligir. Esto es lo que le permite a él cargar con su cruz al enfrentarse con la persecución definitiva. Oremos para recibir la gracia de comprender que Dios nos cuida en medio de todas nuestras pruebas.
