Fr. Gerard's Corner**August 2, 2020****Eighteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

All you who are thirsty, come to the water!

— Isaiah 55:1a

In a few months we will hear the passage from Matthew in which Jesus tells his disciples that those who gave food and drink to the hungry and thirsty will be welcomed into the kingdom. Today, he models that behavior for them. What's more, he involves them in the action so that they would be active participants in this miraculous event. They were the ones who walked through the crowd, handing out food, never running out. They were the ones seeing the delight in the eyes of the families, neighbors, and strangers. They were the ones directly receiving the gratitude of thousands of men, women, and children. They would never forget.

"Bring them here to me," Jesus says to his disciples when they tell him they have five loaves and two fish (Matthew 14:18). The food was hardly enough for just the disciples, let alone a crowd of thousands. But in turning to the Lord the result is able to surpass all human expectation. God provided a miraculous abundance to the Chosen People in the desert, to Isaiah's listeners during the desperate years of the Exile, and to the thousands in this deserted place. Multiplied across time, God continues to provide nourishment in abundance through Jesus, even in places of want and times of despair.

"His heart was moved with pity for them" (14:14). The word Matthew uses, *esplagchnisthe*, is a neologism of sorts, and only found in the Gospels. It turns the Greek word for pity, *splagchna*, into a verb. The English translation is inadequate, for the Greek implies a physical, visceral emotion. Jesus felt intense compassion from deep in his gut for these poor people who followed him into the wilderness. May we feel emotion to such intensity when we see our neighbor in need.

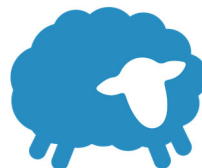

Decimoctavo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Todos ustedes, los que tienen sed, vengan por agua.

— Isaías 55:1a

Dentro de unos pocos meses escucharemos el pasaje del Evangelio de Mateo en el cual Jesús le dice a sus discípulos que aquellos que le dieron comida y bebida al hambriento y sediento serán bien acogidos en el Reino. Hoy les da un ejemplo de tal comportamiento. Es más, los involucra en la misma acción a fin de que sean partícipes de este suceso milagroso. Fueron los discípulos los que caminaron entre la gente distribuyendo la comida que nunca se acabó. Fueron ellos los que vieron deleite en los ojos de las familias, vecinos y desconocidos. Fueron ellos los que recibieron directamente la gratitud de millares de hombres, mujeres y niños. Nunca se les olvidaría.

“Traíganmelos”, le dice Jesús a sus discípulos cuando ellos le dicen que hay cinco panes y dos pescados (Mateo 14, 18). Los alimentos eran apenas suficientes para los discípulos solamente, mucho menos para millares de personas. Pero recurrieron al Señor y el resultado sobrepasó toda expectativa humana. Dios proveyó al pueblo escogido una abundancia milagrosa en el desierto, a la audiencia de Isaías durante los años desesperados del exilio y a millares de personas en este lugar desértico. Dios continúa proveyendo alimento en abundancia, multiplicado a lo largo del tiempo, por medio de Jesús, aun en lugares de escasez y de desesperanza.

Jesús “se compadeció” de la gente (14, 14). La palabra que usa Mateo es *esplagchnisthe*, un tipo de neologismo que sólo se encuentra en los Evangelios. Convierte en verbo la palabra griega *splagchna*, que significa compasión. La traducción al español es inadecuada, ya que el vocablo griego implica una emoción física e intensa. Jesús sintió una compasión intensa desde lo más profundo de su ser por esta pobre gente que lo siguió por el desierto. Que sintamos nosotros una emoción de tal intensidad al ver a nuestro prójimo pasando necesidades.

Nuestras Necesidades Más Profundas

La Palabra de Dios nos brinda hoy una tremenda fiesta. Isaías llama a todos los que tienen hambre y sed para que vengan a satisfacerse en el Señor. El salmista proclama: “Abres tú la mano, y sacias de favores a todo viviente” (Salmo 145:16). San Pablo nos dice que nada puede separarnos del amor de Dios. Finalmente, en el Evangelio, escuchamos sobre el milagro de la multiplicación de los cinco panes y dos pescados con que se alimentaron a más de cinco mil personas. Nuestras necesidades diarias suelen estar cubiertas. Sin embargo, estas lecturas tienen mucho que decir al creyente contemporáneo. Debemos preguntarnos: “¿Dónde está mi hambre más profunda? ¿De qué estoy sediento?”. Una vez satisfechas las necesidades materiales y, en algunos casos, más que satisfechas, mucha gente sigue ansiando tener equilibrio y bienestar espiritual. Al multiplicarse los panes y pescados en el Evangelio de hoy, tal vez nuestra oración es anhelar que nuestras necesidades más hondas sean satisfechas por el único que puede hacerlo: Dios. 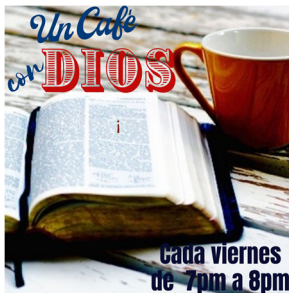

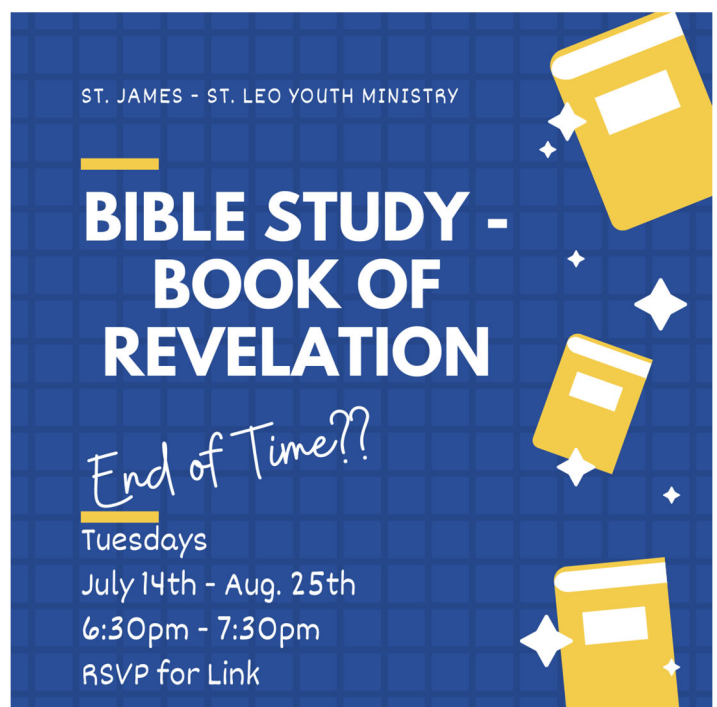
