Fr. Gerard's Corner

July 12, 2020

Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Isaiah couldn't have had the scientific understanding we have today of the water cycle, but he nailed it in the metaphor we read today. Water falls from the sky in the form of precipitation, provides hydration for plants and trees so they can bear fruit, collects in rivers and lakes to provide a necessary resource for humans and animals, then returns to the heavens having nourished and sustained life here on earth. So too does God's word. When spoken from the heavens, it has a creative (think of the creation story in Genesis) and transformative (think of the Transfiguration story in the Gospels) effect. It does God's will here on earth (Jesus as the Word come down from heaven). It nourishes us and sustains us even as it rises back to the heavens to continue the cycle of life.

At first glance, the sower seems to be doing a lousy job of sowing. Why throw seed onto a path or on rocky ground where it has little chance of germinating? Why not take the time to pull the thorns first so that they won't choke the plants later? Wouldn't it make the most sense to sow all the seed in rich soil? But God will not limit where the seed goes. Everyone gets a chance to receive God's grace, no matter what obstacles may be in the way. God's wild extravagance gives goodness a chance to bloom in unexpected and unlikely places, allowing it to bear fruit far beyond expectations.

It is natural to listen to the Gospel and try to determine which spot on the ground we are. Am I the rich soil or the rocky ground? If we're honest, perhaps we'll realize that we can be each of the options at different times. Sometimes God's word just doesn't take root or is choked off by material concerns to which I give greater priority. Let us resolve to be fertile ground for God's living, transformative word as often as possible.

Decimoquinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Isaías no podía tener el entendimiento científico que tenemos hoy sobre el ciclo del agua, pero dio en el clavo con la metáfora que leemos hoy. El agua cae de las nubes en forma de precipitación, provee hidratación a las plantas y árboles para que produzcan sus frutos, se distribuye entre ríos y lagos para proporcionarle a humanos y animales un recurso necesario, y entonces regresa nuevamente a la atmósfera después de haber nutrido y sustentado la vida aquí en la tierra. Eso mismo sucede con la palabra de Dios. Cuando la recibimos de lo alto tiene un efecto creativo (piensen en el relato de la creación en el Génesis) y transformador (piensen en el relato de la Transfiguración en los Evangelios). Hace la voluntad de Dios aquí en la tierra (Jesús bajó del cielo como la Palabra), nos nutre y sustenta, y regresa al cielo para continuar el ciclo de la vida.

A primera vista el sembrador parece estar haciendo un mal trabajo con la semilla. ¿Por qué arrojar semillas a lo largo del camino o en tierra rocosa donde tiene pocas probabilidades de germinar? ¿Por qué no tomarse el tiempo de arrancar los espinos para que no sofoquen a las plantas más tarde? ¿Acaso no tendría más sentido sembrar todas las semillas en terreno fértil? Pero Dios no limita adónde van las semillas. A todos se nos da la oportunidad de recibir la gracia de Dios, sin importar los obstáculos que haya en el camino. La extravagancia desmesurada de Dios le da a la bondad la oportunidad de florecer en lugares inesperados e improbables, permitiéndole que dé frutos más allá de las expectativas.

Es natural escuchar el Evangelio y tratar de determinar en cuál de los terrenos estamos nosotros. ¿Estoy en el terreno fértil o en el rocoso? Con toda honestidad podemos darnos cuenta de que podemos estar en cada uno de los terrenos en diferentes momentos. Algunas veces la palabra de Dios no echa raíces en nosotros o queda sofocada por nuestras preocupaciones materiales, a las cuales les doy mayor prioridad. Estemos resueltos a ser terreno fértil, para recibir la palabra viva y transformadora de Dios.






