## Fr. Gerard's Corner

**Truth shall spring out of the earth,  
and justice shall look down from heaven.**

— *Psalms 85:12*

Peter's courage led him not only to be the only disciple who spoke to the ghost who could be Jesus, but also to dare to walk on water as he did during a violent storm. But when he realized what he was doing, he lost faith. His faith resembled that of someone, in the metaphor we heard a few weeks ago, whose seed of faith was planted on rocky ground. It immediately sprang to life but then withered for lack of roots. On rocky ground, on rocky waters, Peter's faith at this point is not well-anchored. We will see these rocks again when Jesus is arrested and Peter denies him three times. But we know that in the end Peter is the rock. The extravagance of the sower is finally rewarded. Our faith may grow slowly and haltingly, but we are never abandoned.

It's no accident that when an angel appears in scripture, the first thing the angel generally says is, "Do not be afraid." Angels appear much as Jesus did in this passage—like ghosts, like otherworldly presences. Men and women visited by angels or by the presence of God usually initially react with fear. To cope with fear, they call upon their faith. We too struggle with fear: fears about our family, our health, our finances, our future. Faith can help steady us as we struggle with our fears, can enable us to walk through raging waters.

Saint Paul is so selfless that he would sacrifice his own salvation for the sake of the salvation of Israel, "my kindred" (Romans 9:3). We can imagine going to great lengths for our own kin, meaning someone in our own family, but for Paul, kinship includes an entire people. His affection for those close to him extends to entire peoples, indeed all humanity.

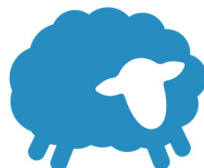

## Cristo Rey San Diego High School

A new high school is opening in San Diego, in partnership with the Congregation of Jesus and Mary. Cristo Rey San Diego High School is on track to open in fall 2020, as part of the Cristo Rey Network of schools. The Eudists of St. James and St Patrick's parishes will serve as the religious sponsors of the school.

Cristo Rey Network schools are private, Catholic, college preparatory high schools, reserved for students from families with limited economic means. They provide a high-quality education to those who would not otherwise have access. What really sets these schools apart is the Corporate Work Study Program: every student works five days per month at an entry level position. Through this job sharing, corporate partners fill one full time equivalent position, and students earn their tuition while gaining job experience.

"Cristo Rey San Diego High School will serve students of families with limited economic means," said Bob Nascenzi, a successful San Diego-based entrepreneur and Founding President of the school. "We will welcome students of all faiths and cultures to partake in a unique learning environment that provides them with a foundation for success."

## El Rincón del Padre Gerardo

### La fidelidad brotó en la tierra y la justicia vino del cielo.

— Salmo 85 (84):12

El valor de Pedro hizo no sólo que hablara con el fantasma que podría ser Jesús, sino también que se atreviera a caminar sobre las aguas durante una tormenta violenta. Pero cuando se dio cuenta de lo que estaba haciendo perdió su fe. Su fe se parecía a la que se sembró en terreno pedregoso, en la metáfora que escuchamos hace unas cuantas semanas. En seguida germinó, pero pronto se marchitó por no echar raíces. Tampoco la fe de Pedro en ese momento tenía raíces, ni estaba bien anclada. De nuevo veremos ese terreno aún pedregoso cuando Jesús es arrestado y Pedro lo niega tres veces. Pero sabemos que al final Pedro es la piedra. La extravagancia del sembrador por fin tiene una recompensa. Aunque nuestra fe crezca lenta y vacilantemente, nunca seremos abandonados.

No es accidentalmente que cuando un ángel aparece en las Escrituras lo primero que dice es: “No temas”. Al igual que Jesús, los ángeles aparecen en este pasaje como fantasmas o presencias del otro mundo. Hombres y mujeres que han experimentado la visita de un ángel o la presencia de Dios reaccionan a primera impresión con temor, y para superar el temor se aferran a su fe. También nosotros luchamos con el temor: temores con respecto a la familia, a nuestra salud, a nuestras finanzas, a nuestro futuro. La fe nos puede ayudar a andar por tierra firme aun en medio de nuestros temores y nos permite la travesía en medio de aguas turbulentas.

San Pablo es tan desprendido que sacrificaría su propia salvación por la salvación de Israel, “los de mi raza” (romanos 9, 3). Seguramente haríamos grandes sacrificios por nuestra propia familia, pero para Pablo la familia incluye a todo un pueblo. Su afecto por todos sus íntimos se extiende a pueblos enteros, es más, a toda la humanidad.

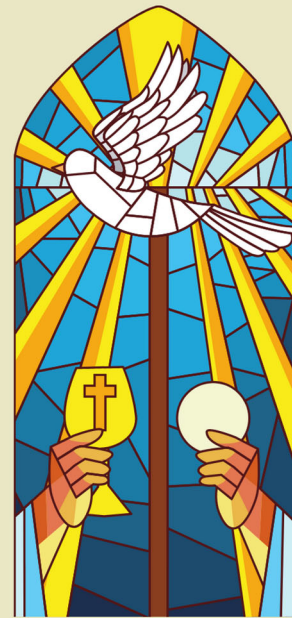

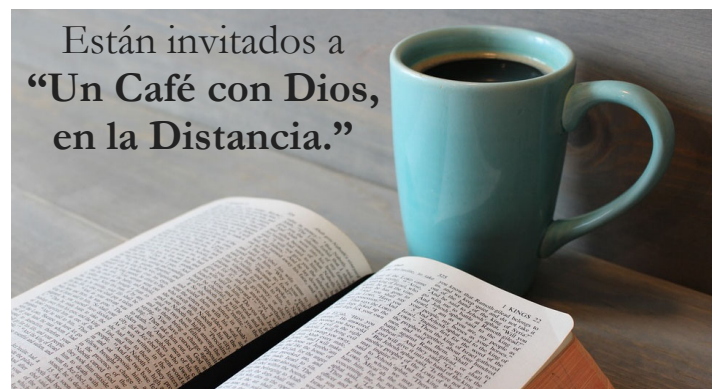
