Fr. Gerard's Corner

"You duped me, O LORD," Jeremiah, the reluctant prophet, exclaims at the beginning of today's first reading (Jeremiah 20:7). The Hebrew verb *pathah* ("duped") can also be translated as "enticed" or "seduced," emphasizing the powerlessness of the prophet in accepting that role. Jeremiah is left in a horrible position, unable to keep it in, but facing abuse and derision when he lets it out. God's word is like fire—it will either burn him up from within or lay waste to his world when he lets it out. When we speak God's word, when we live God's word, it can threaten others, particularly those driven to gain the whole world.

Jeremiah is not the only one faced with difficult things to hear. When Jesus tells his disciples that he will suffer and die at the hands of the authorities it is too much for Peter. Jesus responds by admonishing Peter, telling him, "You are thinking not as God does, but as human beings do" (Matthew 16:23). It is difficult not to think as human beings do, as that is who we are, and impossible to know the mind of God. But at least we can appreciate this when we face what seems an impossible burden: there is an unknowable perspective that makes this sensible. Then we can pray for the strength and courage to bear our cross, despite its incomprehensibility.

We are called to make a sacrifice. Our sacrifice is not as great as our Lord's and may not be as overwhelming as Jeremiah's. But as Paul says to the Romans, we make a sacrifice when we resist conforming ourselves to the world we live in. We sacrifice a self-centered, comfortable life in this world. We are called to deny ourselves, take up our cross, and follow him. Let each sign of the cross we make remind us of the sacrifice we are called to offer.

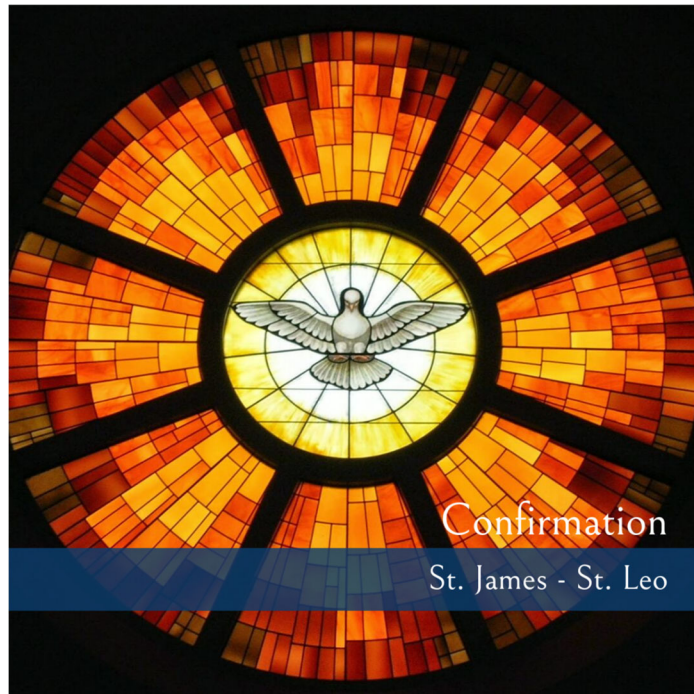
Good Friday Collection

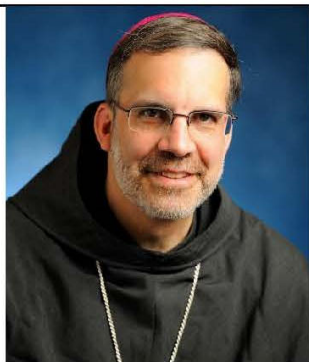

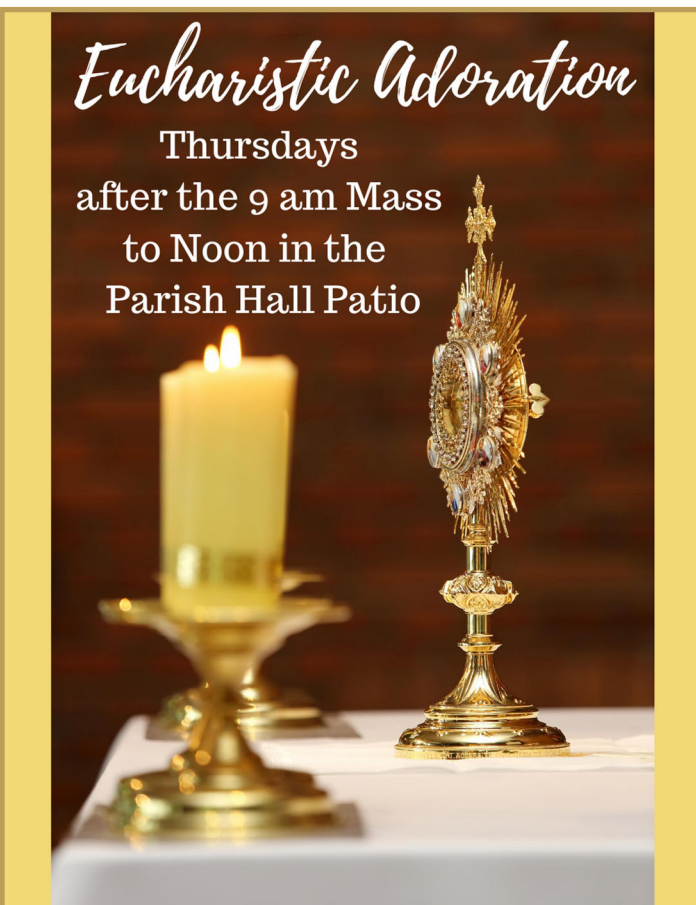

El Rincó del Padre Gerardo

“Me sedujiste, Señor”, exclama Jeremías, el profeta renuente, al comienzo de la primera lectura de hoy (Jeremías 20, 7). En la lengua hebrea el verbo pathah (“seducir”) también puede ser traducido como “persuadir”, lo cual enfatiza la inhabilidad del profeta para aceptar su misión. Jeremías se encuentra en una posición horrible, incapaz de guardar para sí lo que se le pide, pero sabiendo que al sacarlo a la luz se enfrentará con el abuso y la burla. La palabra de Dios es como el fuego: o le arderá por dentro o le causará estragos cuando la deje salir. Cuando nosotros dejamos salir la palabra de Dios, cuando la vivimos, puede que sea una amenaza para otras personas, particularmente para aquellas que quieren ganarse el mundo para sí.

Jeremías no es el único que tiene que escuchar cosas difíciles. Cuando Jesús le dice a sus discípulos que tendrá que padecer y morir a manos de las autoridades es demasiado para Pedro. Jesús amonesta a Pedro diciéndole: “¡... tu modo de pensar no es el de Dios, sino el de los hombres!” (Mateo 16, 23). Es difícil no pensar como un ser humano, pues eso es lo que somos, e imposible es pensar como Dios. Pero al menos podemos pensar lo siguiente cuando nos agobie una carga al parecer imposible: existe una perspectiva inescrutable que le da sentido a eso. Entonces podemos orar para pedir la fortaleza y la valentía para cargar nuestra cruz, por muy incomprensible que nos parezca.

Se nos pide hacer un sacrificio. Nuestro sacrificio no es tan grande como el del Señor y puede que no sea tan abrumador como el de Jeremías. Pero tal como le dice Pablo a los romanos, nuestro sacrificio consiste en no dejarnos transformar por los criterios del mundo en que vivimos. Nosotros sacrificamos una vida egocéntrica y cómoda. Estamos llamados a negarnos a nosotros mismos, cargar nuestra cruz y seguir a Jesús. Cada vez que hagamos la señal de la cruz recordemos el sacrificio que estamos llamados a ofrecer.

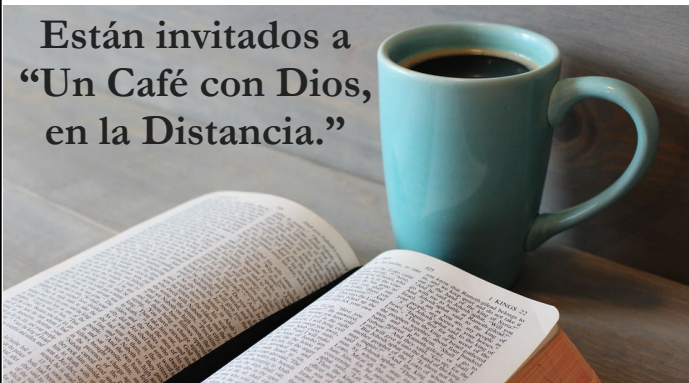
