What is the plan?

High School Youth Ministry encompasses two-year confirmation preparation, which typically begins in 9th grade.

Our Sunday gatherings are the core element of our high school program. Teens and their families are able to attend 5pm Mass, with teens joining us afterward for dinner and social time. Gatherings focus either on a catechetical topic, or a spiritual theme. A typical catechetical evening would consist of a guest speaker with small group discussion. Our spiritual gatherings would consist of prayer, meditation, music, and adoration. We rely on our clergy, music ministry, and key parishioners to support these catechetical and spiritual evenings. There is always room for fun activities on any evening.

We will also lead our teens on a weekend retreat in February at Whispering Winds. This retreat is a fun, engaging, and truly faith-inspiring experience for teens. This year, we partner at the retreat with St. John, Encinitas.

How can I help?
